Paper cat collar

Think you've found a stray cat? If they're approachable, friendly and comfortable being handled, print out this paper collar and follow the instructions below to get a message to their owner.

Instructions:

1. Print this page on normal paper and cut out a collar.
2. Write down your telephone number in the space provided.
3. If the cat allows you to handle them, gently fit the collar around their neck and secure with a bit of sticky tape. Allow a two-three finger gap between the neck and the collar (2cm)
4. If you don't get a response from the owner, or you spot the cat again and the collar is missing, take them to your local vets and they can check for a microchip for free.
